Visit of Papal Nuncio – We welcome His Excellency Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendia to our Cathedral. His Excellency will be celebrating Mass at 10am on Thursday 13th June, along with Bishop Peter and the Cathedral Chapter of Canons.

Next Sunday – is the Day for Life. There will be a second collection taken for the work of Life Charities next weekend.

Friends of the Cathedral – on 22nd June there will be an 11am Mass, in early celebration of the Nativity of St John the Baptist, followed by a BBQ in the garden hosted by **The Friends of the Cathedral**. There will be some children's activities. For anyone who wants to join us, we will then walk to Mother Julian's Shrine, returning to St. John's for Vespers and Mass. Cantonese Chaplaincy – Bishop Peter will be celebrating Mass at the Cathedral on 29th June at 2pm.

Ecumenical Canon – Fr Alan will be installed as an Ecumenical Canon at Norwich Cathedral on Sunday 30th June at 3.30pm during Evensong. All are welcome to attend. This will be followed by a reception. After several queries, Fr Alan would like to make it clear that this is an honorary title bestowed on him by Bishop Graham Usher, the Bishop of Norwich at the Anglican Cathedral. Fr Alan will be staying as the Dean of this Cathedral and will not be able to perform any sacramental rites within the Cathedral of the Undivided Trinity.

From Advent 2024, we will be using an updated translation of the Bible for our readings at Mass, as approved by Rome and our bishops. These changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, to reflect current biblical scholarship and to provide a text for use in a liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive.

The Lectionaries are changed very infrequently but do come at quite a cost! The 4 volumes necessary to cover the whole liturgical year will cost £173.75 each (£695 in total) The Book of the Gospels for use at St John's Cathedral will cost £395. If any person, family, or group would be willing to contribute towards these costs please contact Cathy in the office, one of the clergy or the sacristans. Should you wish to donate to this cause then please mark your envelope clearly with the word 'Lectionary'. People's Missals will be available in the Narthex shop towards the end of the year once they have been printed. Thank you, as always, for your generosity.
