New lectionaries and Book of the Gospels - Thank you to everyone who generously contributed to this appeal to purchase the new editions of the Lectionaries which we will be obliged to use from the beginning of Advent 2024. The total cost of the books amounts to £1090. However, as I have ordered the books early, we are entitled to a 15% discount which brings the amount down to £926.50.

Through the generosity of a number of parishioners, we raised a total of £1 323.75 **Thank you.** This leaves us with a surplus of £397.25. With this surplus, I shall purchase another set of lectionaries for use in the chapels (we currently have two sets of the old lectionary for use on the ambo and in the chapels). The Chapel Set of Lectionaries amounts to £395.00 - leaving us with a positive balance of £2.25! The Chapel Lectionaries are necessary as they are smaller in size than the Ambo set that we have purchased and are used for when we conduct baptisms, funerals or weddings in the side chapels or outside of the cathedral (basically when not using the ambo). This is a good investment over time, as it reduces the wear and tear on the more expensive Ambo set and is more easily transportable.

Once more, I thank the parishioners who so generously supported this funding.
