First Holy Communion & Confirmation Programmes

Please ensure you have your child's baptism certificate details to complete the form. We encourage all those interested to get the forms in as soon as possible. Registration closes on 31 August 2024.

Engagement of Our Faith with Science – our Heritage and Learning Director, Dr Richard Maguire, with the help of Professor George Lomonossoff, have been awarded a grant of up to £10,000 to deliver a project over the next year that will build on the expertise of scientists collaborating with different churches and faiths. The aim is to show how engaging with science can lead to a deeper experience of faith. The project for the Cathedral Church of St John the Baptist is entitled *Human Dignity and Moral Decision Making in the Life Sciences*.
