Historic England, Cathedral at Risk – on Thursday this week our Cathedral was placed on the Historic England Buildings at Risk Register. This highlights two things; firstly, the critical condition of certain parts of our Cathedral especially in the roofs and transepts. Secondly, this highlights the architectural, historical, spiritual and social importance of our Cathedral. Over the next few months, we will be consulting with architects and engineers through Historic England to ascertain the essential works that need to be carried out.

Assisted Suicide Legislation – Parliament will be voting on this bill on 29th November. We know that assisted suicide laws and other jurisdictions have had devastating consequences for the poor, disabled and marginalised.
