Assisted Suicide Legislation – Parliament will be voting on this bill on 29<sup>th</sup> November. We know that assisted suicide laws and other jurisdictions have had devastating consequences for the poor, disabled and marginalised. There will be Adoration and Holy Hour at 6pm in the Cathedral on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> November.
