Please can we ask you to be considerate of our neighbours on a Sunday too, as we have heard that there are parking issues along roads in the vicinity. As a reminder, there is free parking in Zone M on Sundays, just north of the Cathedral. Enter via Dereham Road and walk through Paragon Place. There's also reasonably priced council run parking at Barn Road Car Park (147 spaces) and just a 5-minute walk, or Westwick Street (77 spaces) a 7-minute walk away. The JustPark app also helps you locate suitable parking, which may be someone's private drive.
